

New Ovens and Cooktop

Our church is a busy place with more than 4,500 people visits each month, and many events such as weddings, funerals, lunches, dinners and groups that serve food. The kitchen has been under a lot of pressure and the 12 year old plus oven and cooktop now struggle to meet the needs of the congregation. Through a very generous bequest from a Leisure Time guest, who appreciated how much use the equipment received, and donations from people for whom we provided food for their functions, we have been able to refurbish the oven and cooktop at **no cost to the congregation**.

A committee led by Barbara Thompson, with Faye Wagon, Joanne Boldiston, Barbara Chamberlain, Elwyn Pederson, Yan Emms, Margaret Fraser and some other helpers, reviewed the various possibilities and recommended that we purchase dual ovens and a separate cooktop which will give us greater flexibility of use such as simultaneous differential temperature cooking and address other specific concerns. The new oven and cooktop will be installed during the week of the 21st September. We thank the committee and all those involved in this major refurbishment of the kitchen facilities.
