

The Uniting Church has recently changed its policy on who needs Working with Children Checks (WWCC). Previously it was those involved as leaders in programs for children. Now it is essentially "anyone whom a child attending church might reasonably see as a person in authority". Church Council's Serving Safely team is preparing a list of names of people who we see as needing checks to meet this policy, and we will be asking them to get checks, and offering assistance to do so. If you are asked, please be assured that you are not being suspected or doubted. We have a duty to do all that we can to ensure that children among us are protected, and that UCA policies are followed. Thank you for your understanding.
