


Working With Children Checks - help available with applications

Bulletins Received via Email

The way the bulletins are being sent by email is changing.

In recent times, some people have not been able to receive emails containing the weekly and monthly bulletins. There are two problems, both of which concern the increasing size of the bulletin files. Some Internet Service Providers block emails with large attachments. Sometimes, emails with large attachments cause people's email folders to overflow. We have reached the limit of what can be done to limit the size of bulletins and now have to try something else. In future, bulletins will be made available via 'links' in emails advising of their availability. These typically appear as underlined text, often in colour. If you click on the coloured, underlined text, the bulletin will quickly appear. You can read it online, or download it as you wish.
