

Safe Church Training

Our Church is required to implement Safe Church processes by State and Federal laws, and to respond to the Federal Government's Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse.

Our Synod **Keeping Children Safe Policy** was written to take account of current theological, ethical, legal and practical issues. This Policy meets the Royal Commission's Ten Elements of a Child Safe Organization and our UCA Assembly's National Child Safety Framework.

A Safe Church Training Program has been prepared by Synod, and will be presented here on the above dates. All who occupy a leadership position, or might reasonably be seen by a child as a person of authority, need to attend this Training, as well as have a current WWCC.

Many of us have done Safe Church Training in the past, but it needs to be less than two years ago to be excluded. In addition, Legislation has changed.
