Changes to Leisure Time Operation in 2019

Leisure Time Committee has been concerned with volunteer numbers in 2019, and has decided that, with ageing and retiring volunteers there was no option but to reduce the range of Leisure Time operations.

It was reluctantly agreed that for a trial period of 6 months, church sessions will be reduced to 2 Mondays per month (the first and third). The normal 5 outings per year will be retained, largely on the fifth Monday. A decision will be made in the middle of the year whether this change will be permanent or not.
