Church Council Election 2021

As we pray together in electing our new Church Council, we invite you to think and reflect on who God is encouraging to lead our church at this time.

Duties & Responsibilities of the Church Council

Our Church Council is charged with building our community of God's love. This is a process to identify gifts of spiritual oversight and vision as we enter into 'being Church'.

As a part of our new Church Council, the ministry specifically calls for spiritual leadership of the Congregation. That is, in giving priority in its life to building up the Congregation in faith and love, sustaining members in hope, and leading the congregation to a fuller participation in Christ's mission in the world.

The Church Council, with its committees and communities, is also charged with assisting and leading the congregation to achieve the visions and mission as agreed with the congregation from time to time.

*Be Kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other,
just as in Christ God forgave you.*

Voting - Sunday 28 March 2021

A ballot for election of Church Councillors will be held on Sunday 28 March 2021. There will be nine positions to fill.

A single purpose congregation meeting is called for that day, encompassing all the services of worship, to enable persons attending any of the worship services to vote.

This is to ensure the maximum possible participation by our congregation.

The Uniting Church in Australia regulations indicate that a vote can only be held at a Congregational Meeting and that absentee and postal voting is not permitted.

Ballot papers will ONLY be handed out at worship services held on Sunday 28 March. They will not be available at other times during the day.

Nominees receiving the support of a majority of those participating in the ballot will be declared to be elected.

In accordance with the congregational decision of July 2013, all Church Councillors will be elected as Elders as well as Councillors.

Nomination Forms

These will be available on Sunday 14 February 2021 and at any time after that date from the office or office counter until Sunday 7 March 2021 when nominations will close. Everyone in the congregation is encouraged to carefully consider accepting nomination and to make nominations.

Each nomination requires:-

- a Proposer and Secunder
- a Nominee
- signatures of Proposer, Secunder and Nominee
- the Nominee is requested to provide some personal information to assist our decision-making.

Nominations close on Sunday 7 March 2021

The nomination forms may be returned to the Church Office until the end of that date.

Candidates can obtain from the office a copy of the duties of a Church Councillor as recorded in the Uniting Church in Australia regulations, or by accessing the Uniting Church in Australia web site, or by talking to any Church Council member. This is also available via -
