NEW - Updated Check-In Procedure etc...

We recently notified you of changes in regulations to our QR Code and check-in procedure, and these changes have once again been updated...

Room limits are due to be removed on May 28, and as more vaccination occurs it is likely that distancing requirements, masks when distancing is not possible, and ventilation advice will also be eased.

We will however be required to be very vigilant about checking-in, so that the contacts of any case can be quickly contacted and isolated. It will be a legal requirement for everyone who enters the building to check-in, with fines for any venue not complying.

We are therefore seeking your cooperation in the check-in process using the Services Victoria app. It will help if you have that loaded onto your phone before coming to the church. We are allowed to record temporarily on paper, but need to transfer details to electronic form as quickly as possible. So the more people who can get the app to work, the better.

On Sunday's our 'Check-In Stewards' will be able to assist, however groups meeting during the week will need to nominate a 'Covid-Marshall' from their group to ensure their attendees have been recorded via the app.

Moving into this new regime of strict contact tracing but no other precautions, will require a substantial change of mindset. Some of us will find it quite difficult, and we need to be patient with each other as we adjust again. Remember that we are all learning about this together. Covid is not over on a global scale, but the risks to us now are very small.
