## **Confirmation**



**The Uluru Statement from the Heart and the Voice Referendum**  
Glen Waverley Uniting Church Tuesday 30 May, 7.30-9.00pm

"We ask Australians to accept our invitation to walk with us in a movement of the Australian people for a better future. We call for the establishment of a First Nations Voice enshrined in the Constitution and a Makarrata Commission to supervise a process of agreement-making and truth-telling about our history."

The Voice proposal arises from an invitation to the people of Australia from *The Uluru Statement from the Heart*. This is an opportunity to hear what gave rise to the referendum and consider the vital issues and questions raised by First Peoples.



**Speaker**  
Rev Dr Garry Deverell is a trawoolway man from lutruwita (Tasmania). He is Lecturer and Research Fellow in the School of Indigenous Studies in the University of Divinity, based in Melbourne. Garry's publications include *Gondwana Theology* (Morningstar Press). He is a canon priest of St Paul's Anglican Cathedral in Naarm/Melbourne.
