Backpacks 4 VicKids is an Australian charity providing essential material aid to displaced babies, children and youth. Often children are quickly relocated into foster or kinship care with little more

than what they are wearing. Providing urgently needed essentials can help to restore dignity to children who are experiencing trauma and loss.

A speaker from Backpacks 4 VicKids will be attending the UCAF meeting on June 2nd and we would love to provide them with donations. If you would like to help, please leave new items in the collection bin at the office door by **May 31st**.

Items can be for any age group between Newborn and 18 year olds: Toiletries (face washer, comb, individually wrapped toothbrush, roll on deodorant); Clothing (socks, singlets, tops, trackpants); School items (exercise books, pencils/pens, scissors, lunch box, drink bottle); Baby items (bibs, bottles, sippy cups, soft toys).
