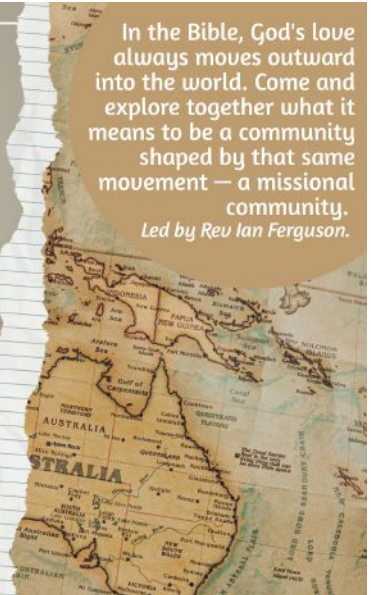
BIBLE STUDY
