Due to the sudden resignation of our Welfare Coordinator on 18th June 2026, we have commenced the recruitment process for a new Welfare Coordinator to join our team.

We are seeking a person who will coordinate the delivery and support of a range of services and support activities to people requiring assistance through the Welfare programmes of Glen Waverley Uniting Church.

We have an experienced Welfare Committee, and a Volunteer Coordinator dedicated to delivering these important services and we are seeking to recruit a professional appropriately skilled person to assume the part time role of Welfare Coordinator here at GWUC.

This is a part time role operating for 6 hours per week. The hours are flexible as are the days and the mix.
